

For the attention of students who are writing exams from 11th Nov. 2020 onwards.

1. In the wake of Covid-19, it has been advised to take all necessary health precautions as has been advised by Government authorities.
2. Those who are coming for examination has to wear mask.
3. Students are requested to bring their own water bottles.
4. Canteen facility will not be available during these days.
5. Students may arrive at College sufficiently early before the starting of examination.
6. Entry to the campus is only through the main gate. No one should crowd together before the gate. Kindly wait by keeping the social distancing.
7. Sharing of things like pen, paper, books, calculators, log tables etc. may spread the disease and hence cannot be allowed.
8. Students have to wear ID card during exam days. Please don't forget to bring Hall ticket.
9. Students' vehicles will not be allowed into the campus. They may park their vehicles outside.
10. All students have to undergo thermal scanning to enter the campus. They have to wash their hands before entering the examination hall. All have to strictly adhere to the instructions given by Covid-19 cell and Examination supervising committee.
11. No one is allowed to stay back in the campus after the examination. They have to leave for home as soon as exam is over.
12. Students are not allowed to enter into garden during these days. No sitting together and discussion are entertained.
13. Kindly wash and bathe before having food at noon after reaching home on the exam days. Remember that your family's safety depends on you too.
