

The newly elected Students' Union organized their Victory Day exactly on the second day after the election that was held on 8th October 2016. Following with was a two-hour celebration of cultural events followed by a series of activities arranged by the students for Union Day. The event was conducted economically with an objective of a fund-raising program for a child's medical care in association with Thavanish, the social service club.

The Union Day celebrations were unveiled by an oath-taking ceremony followed by a stage performance by the music band 'PORALIGALL'. The maiden venture conducted by the Union was the College Arts Day. In the previous years, Arts Day and Sports Day were conducted as a one-day program, but our Union made an innovative move to conduct Arts Day as a Youth Festival pattern titled 'Chilamb'. On stage programs were conducted on 25th and 26th of February.

All the events were charted and scheduled according to the convenience of the participants. There were almost 5 venues inclusive of the garden area. The main objective of the program was maximum participation of the students and direct selection for D-zone without any further selection process. Arts Day was also conducted by categorizing students in to their respective departmental groups. Names and points for each department were published on the scoreboard. Winners were awarded with trophies and certificates on behalf of Chilamb Arts Fest. All participants were also awarded with participation certificates. The Union conducted Intramurals (Inter Departmental) on February 23rd and 24th. Intramurals was merely not a sports event; it was an event open for all students to. Competitions like wrestling, chess, Photo shoot, card competitions were also included in intramurals. The program was conducted without disturbing the regular class hours. About a week before Intermurals sports like football, volleyball, walking race competition etc. were conducted after 3.30pm with the help of teaching and non-teaching staff as a demo for increasing the enthusiasm and participation of students. After 25th February, Annual Athletic Meet was conducted.

The meet included every competition that were included in every other colleges and they were conducted by grouping students as department wise team by giving chest no to students. The Annual Athletic Meet was a two-day program. Trophies and certificates were distributed on behalf of Annual Athletic Meet. The best achievement of the sports day was that the college won the best Sports college award that year. On 8th March 2017, the Union celebrated women's day under the guidance of Rev Fr Jose Thekkan by giving lighted candles to them and conducted a rally at the college. Another campaign conducted by Union was 'Pothichoor'. It was first conducted on Oct 18 2016 after which, the campaign continued every month. Students volunteered to bring individual meal packs from their homes and to be distributed among the needy as well as Medical College inmates. Food parcels were collected in the morning and was distributed without hindering the class hours of students. The College magazine was published during next academic year. An exclusive committee was formed for the organization of the College Magazine.

In short, the Christ College Union 2016-2017 brought about a refreshing and cheerful experience that empowered the students to achieve the impossible and has been able to bring it to the students by upholding the creativity and equality in all possible ways.
