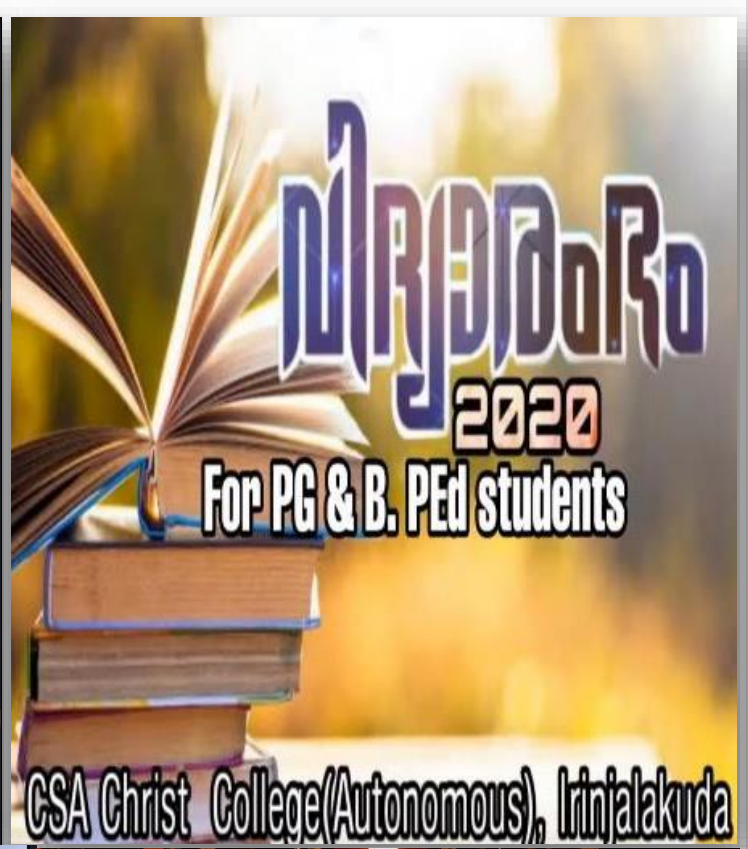
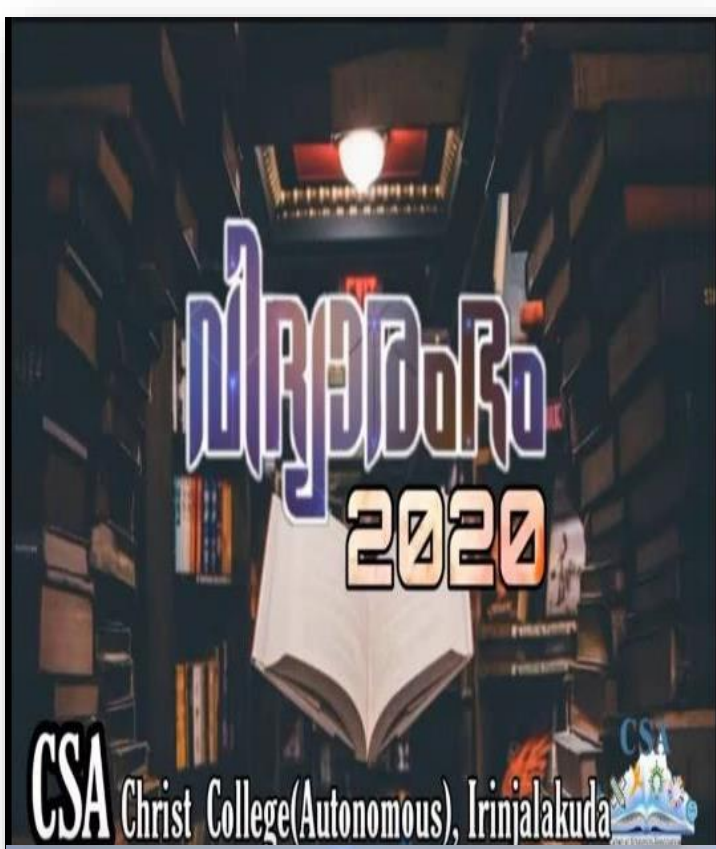



## INDUCTION PROGRAMME -DAY 5



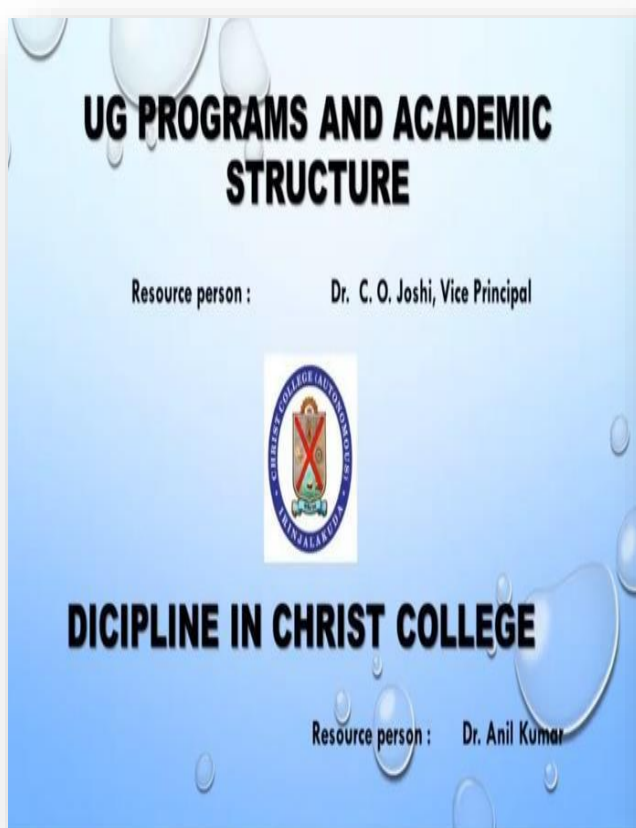

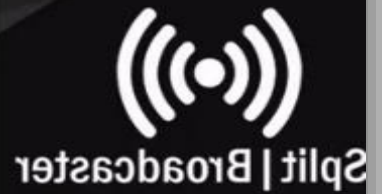
## INDUCTION PROGRAMME -DAY 6
