ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, Government have decided to map the river banks of 44 rivers in the state for the purpose of preparing master plan for rivers and Sand Auditing once in 3 years.

As per Government Order read as 2nd paper above, Government accorded Administrative Sanction for conducting River Bank Mapping and Sand Auditing for 20 Rivers of the state by various agencies.

As per letter read as 3rd paper above, the Director, ILDM has forwarded a list of 15 agencies after short listing the applicants by conducting interview, for performing river bank mapping & sand auditing of 24 rivers in the state as second phase.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to approve the following agencies to conduct river bank mapping & sand auditing of 24 rivers in the state as second phase.

Based on the decision taken in Minutes of the Meeting read as 4th paper above, the 15 new agencies selected for the second phase of river bank mapping and sand auditing should start their work by September, 2017 as per the Guidelines of RMC, Proper training should be given to them. The agencies should carry out a Reconnaissance survey of the river during October-November 2017 and river bank field mapping to be conducted in November 2017 – January 2018. Sand Auditing field survey should be carried out by the new agencies during February to middle of May, 2018 and the final reports on both river bank mapping and sand auditing should be submitted to Government after necessary verification, scrutiny and certification by River Management Cell, ILDM by the end of September, 2018. Intermittent field checks to monitor/scrutinise work progress and correctness should be conducted by RMC/RMC consultant panel members. Report shall also be vetted similarly.

The funds required for the conduct of the river mapping exercise and for the preparation of the report will be met from the River Management Fund of the concerned districts.

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, Government have decided to map the river banks of 44 rivers in the state for the purpose of preparing master plan for rivers and Sand Auditing once in 3 years.

- As per Government Order read as 2nd paper above, Government have accorded Administrative Sanction for conducting River Bank Mapping and Sand Auditing for 20 rivers of the state by various agencies.
- 3. As per Government Order read as 3rd paper above, Government have approved 15 agencies empanelled to conduct River Bank Mapping and Sand Auditing for 15 rivers in the Second Phase. As per the letter read as 4th paper above, the Director, ILDM has requested Government to sanction the following three matters in connection with the approval of river lengths and guidelines for conducting River Bank Mapping and Sand Auditing in Kerala as Second phase viz.
- 1. Allotting Rivers to the newly selected 15 Empanelled agencies.
- 2. Allotting river length for River Bank Mapping and Sand Auditing.
- 3. Fixing standard rates for River Bank Mapping, Sand Auditing and Digitalisation.

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to the following newly selected 15 empanelled agencies to conduct River Bank Mapping and Sand Auditing in 15 rivers in Kerala assigned to them as shown below.

- Sanction is also accorded for 10% increase in the existing standard rate of River Bank Mapping and Sand Auditing from Rs.10,000/-per km to Rs.11,000/-per km in the second phase. For Digitalisation, the standard rate fixed in the first phase was Rs.3,00,000/- per river. This rate is refixed as 1.5 lakhs for rivers with allotted length up to 10 km, Rs.2 lakhs for river length up to 20 km, Rs.3 lakhs for river length up to 50 km and Rs.4 lakhs for river length up to 50 km.
- The fund will be provided to agencies from River Management Fund maintained by the District Collectors of the Districts concerned. The agencies will enter into an MOU with the District Collectors concerned. The format of the MOU and detailed guidelines will be provided by the Director, Institute of Land and Disaster Management.
