Decisions:

First Semester MA

Paper: Writing Kerala History - Historiography and sources.

. In the unit II only selected sources to be discussed in the class room.

- Archaeological sources - Report of Pokalam excavation by B K Thapar
- Epigraphical sources - Jewish copper plates of Bhaskara Ravi Varma.
- Archival sources - Thiruvangadi incident, 1921 C K N Panikkar, Peasant Protests and revolts in Malabar, PPH, New Delhi).

Paper: History of pre-modern societies:

- . Re-arrange the modules I and II under the title Ancient Society - Chinese, Indian, West Asian and Western.
- . Put the topic crusade in Europe (from module VII: Religion and ideology) in to module V: Medieval trade.
- . Remove the topic concept of medieval period as dark age for science and technology, limitations of medieval science from module VI and replace it with dissemination of knowledge in the west.
- . Change the title of the module VII to ideas and ideologies in the medieval period and remove the topics monotheism and polytheism, witchcraft, peasant rebellions and religion in China, Sunni-Shia conflict and replace it with Bhakthi movement in India.

Paper: HIS3C01: Indian national movement: Gandhian Phase (1917-1947).

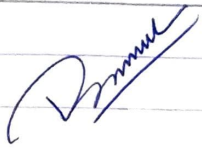
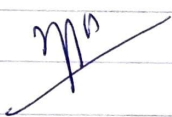
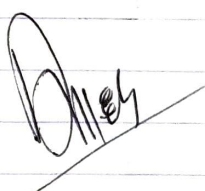
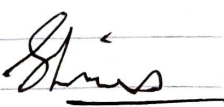

After a detailed discussion of the new revised syllabus for the 2019 admission onwards the following decisions and suggestions were made by the members of the Board of Studies.

- The members unanimously decided to follow the regulation, scheme and syllabus of University of Calicut (revised in 2019) for the 2019 admission onwards.
- Recommended to start a certificate course for P.G. History students of 2020-21 batch onwards. Suggested to start job oriented certificate course.

In the syllabus the following changes were accepted by the Board of Studies.

First Semester

Paper: Method of Historical Research.

- Start the first module with the topic History as knowledge and remove the topics Social research, Historical research, Heuristics and Hermeneutics, qualitative and quantitative

- and methods, interdisciplinary research.
- Remove the topics de-constitution, impact of post-modernism from third module.
- Paper: Pre-modern Kerala: Problems & Perspectives
- Start the module (first module) with the topic 'Cheraman Perumal legend' and remove the topic 'Parasurama legend'.
- Replace the word 'Anjithuvazheha' for Sthanam hanam in section C - Granthavasis. Replace the text for study 'description of Kollam nagaram in Unnineeli Sandesam' and remove the topic description of social life in Malabar, section three, Tudat ul Muya liddin.
- Paper: Problems and Perspectives and debates in early Indian History.
- Change the title of the module II as 'State and Society in early period'.

Second Semester

Paper: History of modern Kerala: Problems and Perspectives

- Remove the topic 'Velu Pillai' from the first module titled 'Colonial and modern historiography' and add C Achutha Menon. Remove the topic 'Search for primary sources: Babington, Bruce Foote' also from the first module.
- In the second module titled 'Modern Kerala and the phases of change' add the topic 'modernity in Travancore and Cochin' after the topic 'Changes in the economy and society'. Replace the word 'Mysorean interlude' with the word 'Mysorean rule in administration and land relations'.

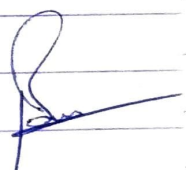
