RULES AND REGULATIONS

- This is an inter-collegiate group dance competition for girls from all the colleges and Deemed-to-be-Universities (inclusive of Engineering, Training, Medical and Nursing colleges) across the state of Kerala.
- Only one team is allowed from a instution (No registration fees)
 Breakfast and Lunch will be provided by the college (Total participants + 2)
- 3. Registration slots are open only for the first 20 teams.*
- Last date of registration 15th January 2026
- Teams must carry an authorisation letter with the names of the participants from
 respective colleges. College ID cards of the participants will be verified on the day
 of the competition.
- 6. Competition is strictly based on semi-classical dance form.
- 7. Film songs can be used but cinematic dance will not be allowed.
- 8. Minimum of 6 members and a maximum of 10 members per team is allowed.
- Usage of props and production material is allowed. These have to be carried by the participant themselves and won't be provided by the host college.
- 10. Judgement will be based on choreography, rhythm, synchronization, costume and overall presentation and performance of the students.
- 11. Judges' decisions are FINAL and cannot be APPEALED.
 - * Final decision on the number of teams will be taken by the organizing committee of Arts Kerala
