METHODOLOGY:



The survey involved 202 respondents, and a five-point Likert scale was employed, where a value of 1 represents a strongly agree opinion, and a value of 5 indicates a strongly disagree opinion. The institution values this feedback loop as a crucial element in maintaining the effectiveness and relevance of the curriculum.
















































Important Suggestions on curriculum and syllabus from teachers
