Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent there to with Mathematics group only are eligible for admission to B.Sc Mathematics

Index Mark:- Total marks obtained for Part III + the marks obtained for the Mathematics for BSc Mathematics

Tie Break:-If there is tie priority must be given to the candidates who secured more marks in the main subject concerned. If there is a tie again the marks of compulsory subsidiary subjects and then the marks obtained for the second subsidiary subject are to considered. Even after there is tie the marks obtained in English, the second language are considered and at last general conditions are applied.

B.Sc. Mathematics & Computer Science (Double Major) Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent there to with Mathematics group only are eligible for admission.

Index Mark:- Total Plus Two marks + twice the marks secured in Mathematics + 50 marks for stuying subjects related to Computer Science (Computer Science/Computer Application/Information Technology/Informatics Practice/ Additional Mathematics + Bonus marks, if any

Tie Break:- priority must be given to candidates who secured more marks in Mathematics. If there is a tie again, priority must be given first for the marks of Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/ Additional Mathematics, the marks obtained in English, second language are considered and finally general conditions are applied

B.Sc. Physics Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent there to with Physics as a compulsory paper are eligible for admission

Index Mark: - Total marks obtained for Part III + the marks obtained for Physics

Tie Break:-If there is tie priority must be given to the candidates who secure more marks in the main subject concerned. If there is a tie again the marks of compulsory subsidiary subjects and then the marks obtained for the second subsidiary subject are to considered. Even after there is tie the marks obtained in English, the second language are considered and at last general conditions are applied

B.Sc. Chemistry Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent there to with Chemistry as a compulsory paper are eligible for admission

Index Mark:- Total marks obtained for Part III + the marks obtained for Chemistry

Tie Break:-If there is tie priority must be given to the candidates who secure more marks in the main subject concerned. If there is a tie again the marks of compulsory subsidiary subjects and then the marks obtained for the second subsidiary subject are to considered. Even after there is tie the marks obtained in English, the second language are considered and at last general conditions are applied

B.Sc. Zoology Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent there to with Biology as a compulsory paper are eligible for admission

Index Mark: - Total marks obtained for Part III + the marks obtained for Biology

Tie Break:-If there is tie priority must be given to the candidates who secure more marks in the main subject concerned. If there is a tie again the marks of compulsory subsidiary subjects and then the marks obtained for the second subsidiary subject are to considered. Even after there is tie the marks obtained in English, the second language are considered and at last general conditions are applied

B.Sc. Geology Honours

Eligibility :- Candidates who have studied science subjects at Plus two level are eligible for admissions to B.Sc. programme in Geology, since Geology is taught as a subject at plus two level in both Science and Humanities stream, those candidates who have studied Geology at Plus two level are also eligible for admission.

Index Mark :- Science Stream - Total marks obtained for Part III + Highest marks scored for any one of the Science subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Geology, Computer Science and

Mathematics. **Humanities Stream** - Total marks obtained for Part III + marks obtained for the Geology

Tie Break :- In case of the preference shall be given as the following order, 1. Candidates with Geology as one of the optional subjects. 2. Marks of Geology. 3. Marks of Chemistry. 4. Marks of Mathematics. 5. Date of Birth. **Humanities Stream** 1. Marks of Geology, 2. Marks of Computer science ,3. Date of Birth

B.Sc. Psychology Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies)the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto are eligible for admission

Index Mark:- Total marks + a weightage of 50% marks of Psychology as optional subjects in HSE or equivalent

Tie Break:-If there is a tie, the priority must be given to those candidates who score more marks in the optional subjects concerned. Again, if there is a tie, then the total marks in English, then the total marks in additional/Second language are considered. After that the general conditions are applicable

B.Sc. Computer Science Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with Mathematics/ Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/Informatics/ Additional Mathematics are eligible for admission. (U.O.No.GAI/JI/4756/1999 dated 11.01.2002)

Index Mark:- Total Part III + marks secured for Mathematics in the case of Science group with Mathematics as one of the subject AND Total Part III + marks secured for Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/Informatics/ Additional Mathematics in the case of other combinations without Mathematics as one of the subject. If the Candidates has studied both Mathematics and any one of the following subjects Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/Informatics/ Additional Mathematics then the marks secured for Mathematics or Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/Informatics/ Additional Mathematics whichever is higher will added

Tie Break:- If there is a tie in the index marks priority must be given to Mathematics/Computer Science as the case may be. If there is a tie again the marks of the second subsidiary subject

marks of English and then the marks for second language will be considered before going to general conditions

B C A (Bachelor of Computer Application) Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent there to with Mathematics/ Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/Informatics/ Additional Mathematics as one of the subjects are eligible for admissions (U.O. No.GAI/J1/2453/1997 dated 06.10.2000 and GA I/J1/1597/2005 dated 11.07.2005)

Index Mark:- Total Part III + marks secured for Mathematics in the case of Science group with Mathematics as one of the subject AND Total Part III + marks secured for Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/Informatics in the case of other combinations without Mathematics as one of the subject. If the Candidates has studied both Mathematics and any one of the following subjects Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/Informatics then the marks secured for Mathematics or Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology which ever is higher will added

Tie Break:-If there is a tie in the index marks priority must be given to Mathematics/Computer Science as the case may be. If there is a tie again, the marks of the second subsidiary and marks of English and then the marks for additional language/second language after general conditions

B.Com /B.Com Taxation/ B.Com Professional Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with at least one commerce subject are eligible for admissions to the B.Com / BBA degree course. Candidates who have not studied commerce subject for Higher Secondary or an equivalent examination not less than 45% marks are also eligible. A concession of 5% will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need get only a pass. (U.O. No.GAI/A2/1658/2007 dated 28.02.2008)

Index Mark:- Total marks + 25 marks for each commerce papers subject to maximum of 50 marks. COMMERCE PAPERS Accountancy/ Accountancy and Auditing/ Accountancy with AFS/

Accountancy with Computer Accounting/ Accountancy (Analysis of Financial Statements)/
Accountancy (computerized accounting)/ Accounts/ Banking Assistance/ Banking with
Secretarial Practice/ Book Keeping and Accountancy/ Book-Keeping & Basic Mathematics/
Book-Keeping & Accountancy/ Business Studies/ Business Studies with Functional
Management/ Business Mathematics/ Catering and Restaurant Management/ Commerce/

Tie Break:-If there is a tie in the index marks, those who studied commerce in the Plus Two or equivalent get preference. If there is tie the marks in the commerce subjects will be considered first, then the marks of English and then the marks of Additional language/second language will be considered. Finally general conditions are applicable

B A English & History (Double Major) Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies)the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto are eligible for admission

Index Mark:- Total Plus Two marks + twice the marks secured Part I English (i.e. Additional second languages) + 20 marks for Part III Optional English Literature/Communicative English in HSE or equivalent+ 50 marks for History/Islamic Jurisprudence (Faqh and Aquaid)/Islamic History/History of Islam and history Arabic Literature (only for English and History)

Tie Break:-If there is a tie, the priority must be given to those candidates who score more marks in the Additional Second Language concerned. Again if there is a tie, then the total marks in English, then the total marks in second language are considered. After that the general conditions are applicable

B.A. Economics Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto are eligible for admission

Index Mark:- Total Plus Two marks + a weightage of 50 marks for those who have studied Economics as optional subjects in HSE or equivalent

Tie Break:-If there is a tie, the priority must be given to those candidates who score more marks in the optional subjects concerned. Again if there is a tie, then the total marks in English, then the total marks in Additional/Second language are considered. After that the general conditions are applicable

B.Sc. Food Technology Honours

Eligibility: Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with Science and Mathematics are eligible for admisson. (U.O. No.GA I/J1/7359/2003 dated 20.01.2010

Index Mark: Total marks obtained for part III+ the average marks obtained for Physics and Chemistry.

Tie Break: If there is tie priority must be given to the candidates who secure more marks in the main subject concerned. If there is a tie again the marks of compulsory subsidiary subjects

B.Sc. Hotel Management & Catering Science Honours

Eligibility: Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto, with not less than 50% is eligible for admissions. A concession of 5% will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need get only a pass. (U.O.No.GAI/J2/2907/2003 dated concerned

Index Mark: Total Plus Two marks only

Tie Break : If there is a tie, the priority must be given to those candidates who score more marks in the optional subjects concerned. Again if there is a tie, then the total marks in English, then the total marks in additional second language are considered. After that the general conditions are applicable.

B.A. Functional English Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies)the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto are eligible for admission

Index Mark:- Total marks + Twice the marks secured in English. A weightage of 20 marks will be given to those who have studies English, Functional English, Communicative English as optional subject for HSE or an equivalent examination.

Tie Break:- there is a tie in the ranking, the priority will be given to those who got more marks in English. If there is again a tie, marks in Additional /Second Language are considered and then the general conditions are applicable.

B.A. English Literature Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies)the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto are eligible for admission

Index Mark:- Total Plus Two marks + twice the marks secured Part I English (i.e. Additional second languages) + 20 marks for Part III Optional English Literature/Communicative English in HSE or equivalent Examination

Tie Break:- If there is a tie in the ranking the priority will be given to those marks in English. If there is again tie, marks in Second Language is considered and then the general conditions are applicable.

B S W (Bachelor of Social Work) Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies)the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto are eligible for admission

Index Mark: Total Plus two marks only

Tie Break:- If there is a tie in the ranking the priority will be given to those candidates who score more marks in the optional subjects concerned. Again tie, then total marks in English, then the total marks in additional Second language are considered. After that the general conditions are applicable.

B B A (Bachelor of Business Administration) Honours

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with at least one commerce subject are eligible for admissions to the B.Com / BBA degree course. Candidates who have not studied commerce subject for Higher Secondary or an equivalent examination not less than 50% are also eligible. A concession of 5% will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need get only a pass. (U.O. No.GAI/A2/1658/2007 dated 28.02.2008)

Index Mark:- Total marks + 25 marks for each commerce papers subject to maximum of 50 marks. COMMERCE PAPERS Accountancy/ Accountancy and Auditing/ Accountancy with AFS/ Accountancy with Computer Accounting/ Accountancy (Analysis of Financial Statements)/ Accountancy (computerized accounting)/ Accounts/ Banking Assistance/ Banking with Secretarial Practice/ Book Keeping and Accountancy/ Book-Keeping & Basic Mathematics/ Book-Keeping & Accountancy/ Business Studies/ Business Studies with Functional

Management/ Business Mathematics/ Catering and Restaurant Management/ Commerce/ Commercial Correspondence and Commercial Geography/ Commercial Geography & Commercial Correspondence/ General insurance/ Management/ Marketing/ Marketing and Salesmanship/ Office Secretaryship/ Reception, Book Keeping and Communication

Tie Break:-If there is a tie in the index marks, those who studied commerce in the Plus Two or equivalent get preference. If there is tie the marks in the commerce subjects will be considered first, then the marks of English and then the marks of Additional language/second language will be considered. Finally general conditions are applicable

Information Technology

Eligibility:- Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with Mathematics/Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/ Informatics Practice/Informatics/WebTech/Additional Mathematics are eligible for admission.

Index Mark:- Total Part III + marks secured for Mathematics or Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/ Informatics Practice/ Informatics/ Web Technology/ Additional Mathematics whichever is higher will added.

Food Processing Technology

Eligibility: Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with Science and Mathematics are eligible for admisson. (U.O. No.GA I/J1/7359/2003 dated 20.01.2010

Index Mark: Total marks obtained for part III+ the average marks obtained for Physics and Chemistry. An additional 25 marks will be awarded for VHS passout students.

Tie Break: If there is tie priority must be given to the candidates who secure more marks in the main subject concerned. If there is a tie again the marks of compulsory subsidiary subjects
