## UPSC Civil Services Entrance Coaching


The PG Department of English, in association with IQAC, Christ College (Autonomous), Irinjalakkuda organized a four-week intensive coaching series for the UPSC Civil Services examination from 14<sup>th</sup> September 2020 to 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2020. Inaugurated by our dear Principal Rev. Fr. Dr. Jolly Andrews, the initial session was privileged with the keynote address delivered by Mr. Sreejesh MG, Co-ordinator, Civil Service Academy, Trivandrum. The initial response towards the initiative proved appreciable that about 109 students our campus as well as outside intimated their interest to the Google sheet which we shared, out of which almost 62 students were present in the first session. Later we had a consistent participation between 20 and 24 students per lecture. The sessions were scheduled for Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, from 3 PM to 6 PM respectively.

The areas covered across the sessions included the following:

1. Current affairs based on The Hindu
2. Indian Polity
3. History
4. Indian Economy
5. Geography
6. Environment
7. General Science

Including the inaugural session, the links for the Google Meet sessions were shared through MOODLE platform, wherein we created a separate course for the same. We had 12 sessions totaly. The training series concluded on 14.11.2020 and the follow-up discussions and learnings are initiated through a productive WhatsApp group created thereafter.

Now, the next step planned in this regard is the foundation course for the first-year students, of which the initial preparations are going on.

  
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## UPSC Civil Services Foundation Course

The PG Department of English, in association with IQAC, Christ College (Autonomous), Irinjalakkuda is all set to kickstart a six-month intensive coaching series for the UPSC Civil Services examination from 9th January 2021. The foundation course, organized for the first-year students, titled as 'Mission 2021' organized an initial gathering on 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2021. IQAC Coordinator Mr. Robinson introduced the resource person Mr. Sreejesh MG, Coordinator, Civil Service Academy, Trivandrum, following which Mr. Sreejesh extended a motivational talk for the participants. It was indeed a delightful moment to receive an offer from Vedic IAS Academy, assuring a free civil service coaching for a student suggested from Christ College (Autonomous). As part of this, a standard Prelims-model test (50 marks) was conducted among the registered participants on 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2021, and the winner Jayakrishnan M (English Double Main) was announced in the official gathering of 5<sup>th</sup> January.

Google form was circulated among the students for registration, from which we had an appreciable response. Following this, an official WhatsApp group was created to forward the instructions to the participants of the coaching. Participants have already been enrolled in the Moodle platform and live sessions will be conducted via Google Meet. The sessions are scheduled for Saturdays, and Sundays from 5.30 PM to 7.30 PM respectively. With an aim to provide in-depth, detail sessions, this time, we have fixed Rs.2000/- as the coaching fees per student.

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### 2020-2021 CMA Add-on-Course Batch

The class for CMA batch 2020-21 was started in the month of November 2020. 22 students were registered for the foundation of CMA. The classes were provided for the students for their foundation exam. The faculties for CMA were Ms. Sruthy CMA & Mr. Aju CA. The CAT exam was conducted in the month of January 2021. 97% of students cleared CAT exam. Due to the pandemic situation, online classes were provided for CMA Inter Group I.

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
### **Report on CA Add-on-Course (2020-2021 Batch)**
