

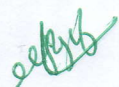

The Pw.D thesis plagiarism check should be continued as per the regulation from University of Calicut.

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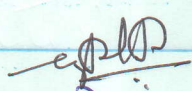
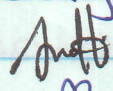
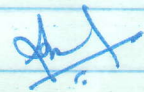
