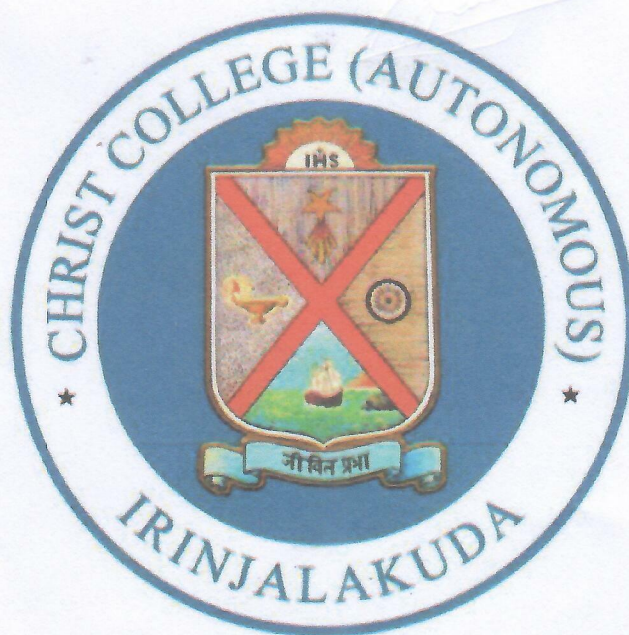

Secretary, Fr. Dr. Jolly Andrews presented the minutes of the previous Governing Council meeting and explained the actions taken report. The members of the Governing Council confirmed the minutes of the meeting.

Chairman of the meeting Fr. Joy Peenikkaparambil addressed the meeting by mentioning the achievements of the college. He appreciated the college for securing 87<sup>th</sup> position in NIRF ranking. He also congratulated the college for securing the Biodiversity Award, Agricultural Contribution Award from Government of Kerala and Best Sports College recognition from the University of Calicut. He also informed the meeting that the college is preparing to become an aided university.

Principal, Dr. Fr. Jolly Andrews presented the major achievements and activities of the college since the last meeting. He informed the members about the initiatives taken by the college for the overall development of the college.

Conferment of Academic Council decisions	<p>Principal Dr. Fr. Jolly Andrews presented the minutes of the Academic Council meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> October 2025. Governing Council decided to approve the proposals from Academic Council.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Conduct at least one AAA audit utilizing external experts</li> <li>• Organize workshop for project proposal writing with the help of external experts.</li> <li>• Reserve some seats for outside state students by creating supernumerary seats/over and above seats.</li> <li>• suggested to introduce special elective streams utilizing the expertise of the faculty members available in the departments</li> <li>• Organize programs to ensure the industry readiness of the graduating students.</li> <li>• Approved the curriculum of BVOC Programmes and Integrated Geology programme in align with FYUGP regulations of the University of Calicut.</li> <li>• Approved all BOS recommendations: Syllabus of BVOC IT, BVOC FPT and Integrated Geology in align with FYUGP regulations; Syllabus of elective course having specialization in “Biomedical Science” by Zoology; Syllabus of BSc AI and BCA AI from Computer Science; Syllabus revision of minor courses and the MDC course by Mathematics; Syllabus of certificate course titled “Psychology of aging and Wellbeing” by department of Psychology in collaboration with Life</li> </ul>


	<p>Learning Center, University of Calicut; Syllabus for certificate course in collaboration with Wipro titled, “Enterprise Digital Workspace” by Computer Science; and Syllabus for double major programmes with Statistics as one of the major. It is also approved to forward the request of BOS of BPES to the university for the correction in the grading system and passing criteria of MPES programme published by the University of Calicut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New programmes suggested by the Academic Council; BSc in Artificial Intelligence, BCA in Artificial Intelligence and MSc Clinical Psychology (Additional Batch) was approved to start from 2026-27 academic year and ITEP-Integrated Teacher Education Programmes from 2027-28 academic year was also approved.</li> <li>• Approved to establish the CODE program in Collaboration with IIT Madras for the students of Christ College.</li> </ul>
IKS Cell Activities	<p>Principal briefed the activities of the IKS Cell of the college. Governing Council approved to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Apply for an IKS Center in the college titled “Nadyapadasala”</li> <li>• Forward the project proposal from IKS Cell to ICSR</li> <li>• Apply for various Indian regional language promotion projects</li> <li>• Continue certificate course on Pancharimelam utilizing the expertise of local artists</li> <li>• Offer certificate course and diploma course in collaboration with Central University Sanskrit Learning Center</li> </ul>
Examination related reforms and Approval of Mark lists	<p>Principal presented the result analysis of 2025 pass out batches. Governing Council approved the proposal of providing option to complete the minor pathway on regular mode for FYUGP students those selecting a new minor course from second/third semester. It is also approved to sanction the previously completed minor as an extra credit course. The same provision may also be extended to students joining from other colleges by ‘College Transfer Option’.</p>
Any other relevant matter	<p><b>Laptop Rental Scheme</b> Principal presented laptop rental scheme for eligible students at a nominal rent with refundable security deposit. Governing Council approved the proposal.</p> <p><b>Academic Visibility Initiatives</b> University Nominee, Prof. Dr. V V Radhakrishnan suggested to encourage the faculty members to become a member or fellow of nationally reputed institutions or organizations. He also suggested to initiate a Peer reviewed research journal from the college with ISSN number. These initiatives will help to enhance the academic visibility of the college.</p> <p><b>One Department-one National Seminar</b> UGC Nominee Prof. Dr. K George Thomas suggested to organize at least one national seminar from every department and invite experts from nationally reputed institutions to interact with students of the campus.</p>

The meeting ended at 2.00 PM with the vote of thanks by Dr. Fr. Wilson Tharayil. He thanked all the Members for sparing their valuable time to attend the meeting.
