Students IQAC Report



2. Survey conducted by the Students IQAC

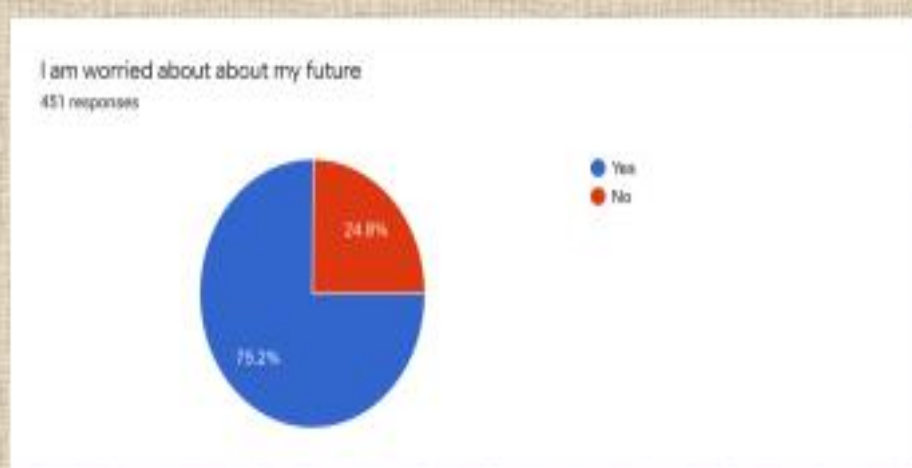

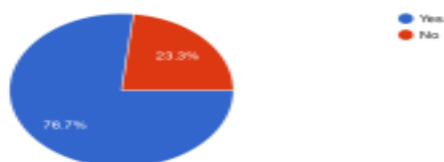

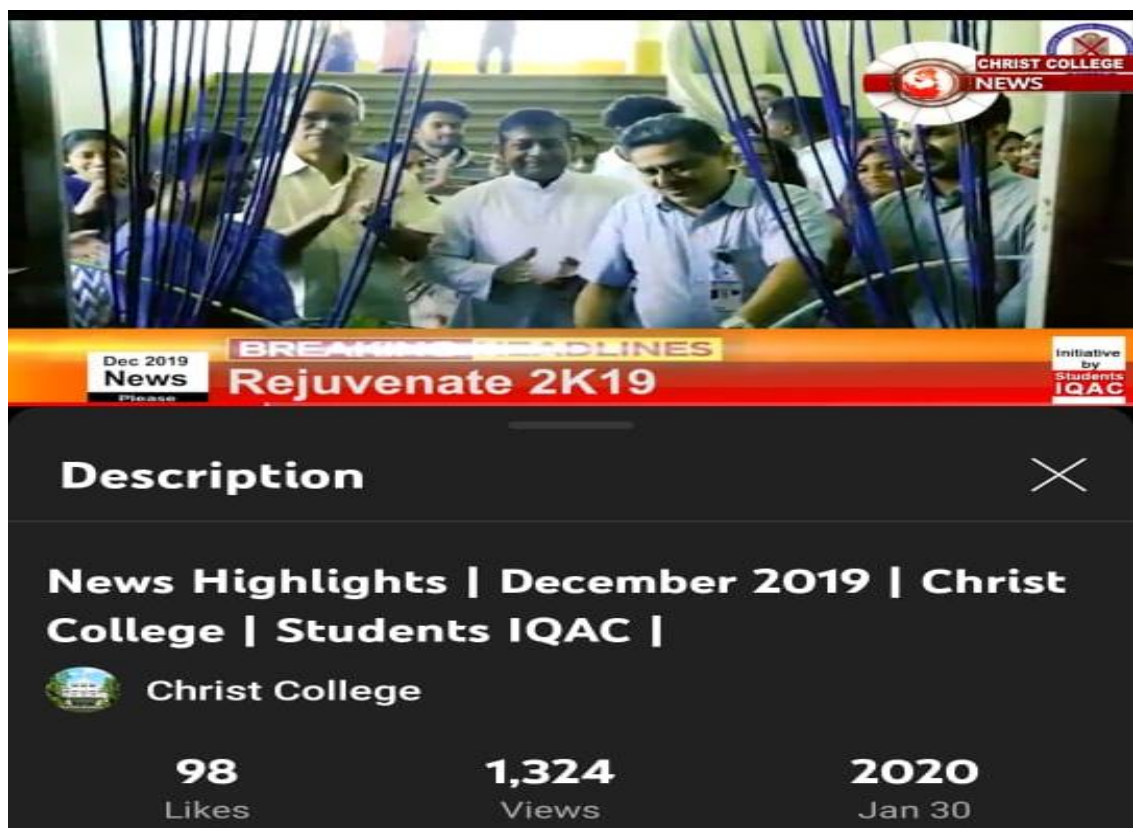

3. News highlights

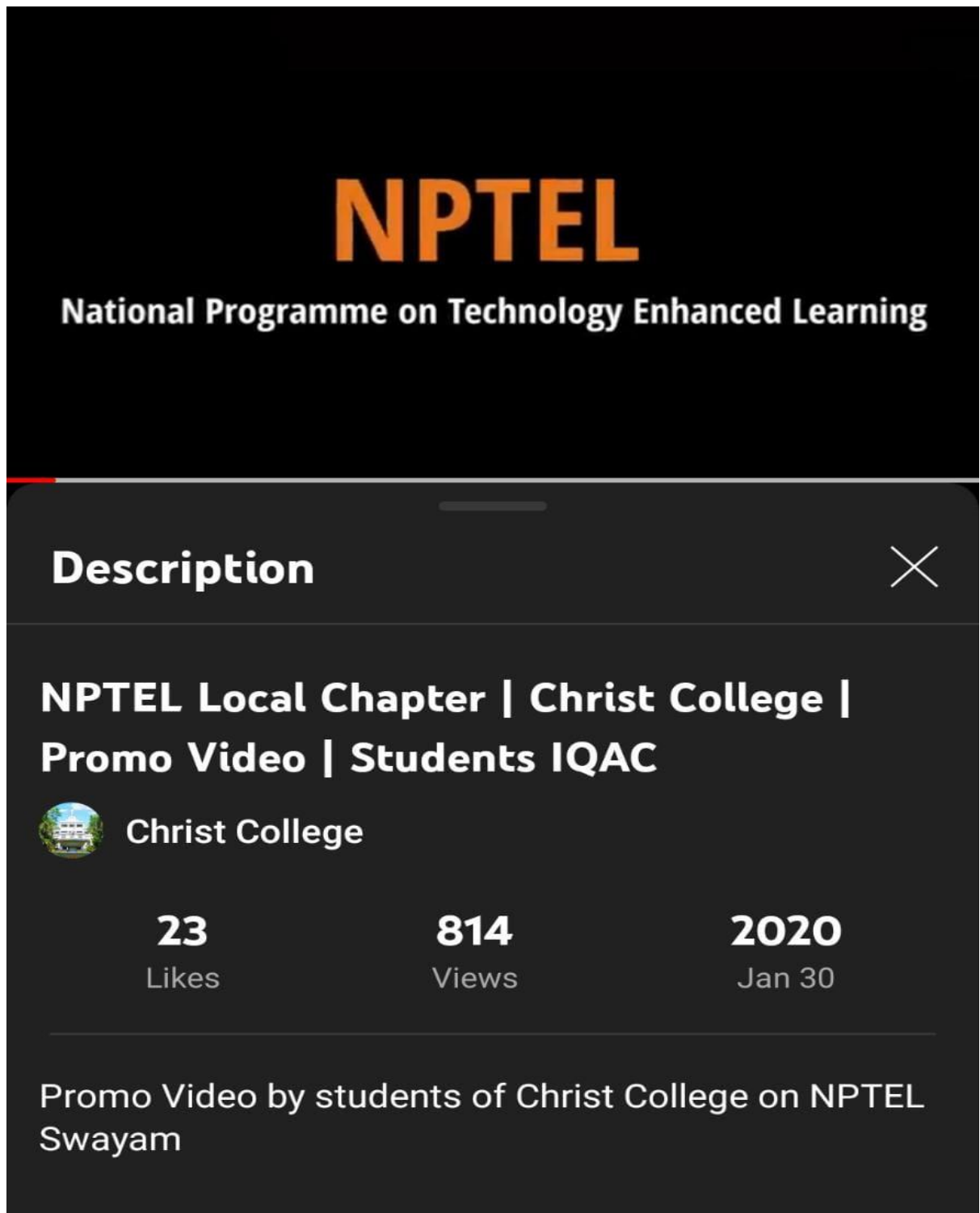

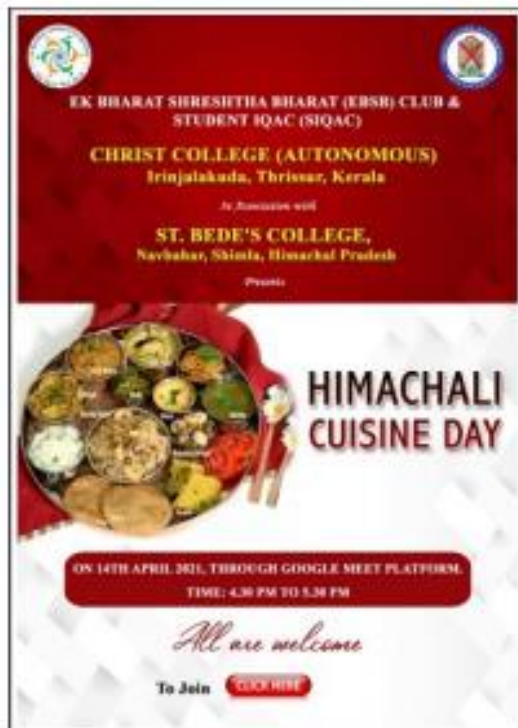
