

## **Invitation of Applications for Commerce (Paper I & II) Coaching Programme.**

The Research & P G Department of Commerce, Christ College (Autonomous), Irinjalakuda is organising a complimentary coaching programme for eligible minority students in the Commerce stream (Papers I and II) for the academic year 2025-26 in collaboration with the Department of Minority Welfare, Government of Kerala

### **Programme Implementation**

The programme shall comprise 72 teaching hours of intensive instruction, delivered over 12 days at 6 hours per day.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

Prospective applicants must satisfy the following conditions:

- Must belong to a notified minority community.
- Must be currently pursuing Second Year of M. Com Programme having secured a minimum of 55% marks in the First-Year M. Com Examination **OR** be a passed-out M. Com student with a minimum aggregate of 55% in Final M. Com Degree Examination.

### **Selection Priorities**

As per DMW guidelines, the selection of candidates will adhere to the following priorities:

- Primary priority shall be accorded to students from Backward Communities and families classified as Below Poverty Line (BPL).
- Students from Above Poverty Line (APL) families with an annual income not exceeding ₹8,00,000 may also be considered, subject to the availability of seats.

### **Financial Provision**

The entire cost of the programme is funded by the Department of Minority Welfare. No fees will be charged from the selected students.

### **Application Procedure**

Eligible students must submit their applications on or before the specified date. Application can be downloaded from the college website.

### **Important Date**

Last date of receiving applications: **10th September 2025 (before 4:00 pm)**
