The meeting held on 08/02/2019 at 4.00PM, started with a prayer. Fr. Joy P. T, Vice -principal, delivered the Welcome speech. Fr. Jacob Njerinjampilly, President & Manager, gave the Presidential address.

- Dr. Mathew Paul Ukken, Principal, presented the following details.
- 1. The Principal informed the meeting that Fr. Dr. Jose Thekkan Award Jury selected Dr. C. Krishnan, faculty of Economics and Principal, Govt. College Kolancherry. The Principal informed the meeting about the decision to conduct the award presentation ceremony on 09/02/2019 in the college auditorium. The Principal also informed the meeting that Dr. Alphons Kannanthanam, Union Minister of the State for Culture and Tourism, has kindly agreed to inaugurate the function and that Rev. Fr. Pauly Kannookkaden, Bishop of Irinjalakuda diocese, agreed to give a Benedictory address.
